CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT LEVEL 2 (CNA-2) PROGRAM

Caregiver Training Institute is excited to offer our OSBN-approved CNA-2 program, which combines Acute Care, Dementia Care and Restorative Care, plus core competencies, into a comprehensive training program including all aspects of the CNA-2 role in a variety of work settings. The CNA-2 training program expands upon the NA-1 program, delving in more depth into Dementia Care and Restorative Care and the technical skills required of employees in the hospital setting. The course consists of a total of 88 hours, 60 hours in class and lab and 28 hours in the clinical setting. Students will be actively involved in the classroom, labs and a clinical rotation in an acute care/hospital setting.

COURSE OPTIONS

The course is offered on alternating **Day** and **Evening** schedules.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- **Must be at least 18 years of age.**
- **Must be able to read, write and communicate in English fluently.**
- **Must be listed on the OSBN registry as a CNA in good standing.** OSBN regulations state that students must have an unencumbered Oregon CNA-1 certificate prior to attending the first day of class. NO EXCEPTIONS. If you are transferring from another state, you must wait until you are listed on the OSBN website as a CNA in good standing in Oregon to enroll in the CNA-2 program.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

*****At least two (2) business days prior to the first day of class, students must complete an information session; submit all completed enrollment paperwork/eligibility documentation to the business office; select a class/clinical schedule; and pay their tuition fees.*****

ENROLLMENT PROCESS

- Create an Online Student Profile.**
- View a no-obligation Online CNA-2 Information Session.**
- Go to the school to submit your paperwork and complete the registration process.** All enrollment paperwork must be completed, signed and received by the school business at least two (2) business days prior to the first day of class.
- Pay your program fees – Tuition \$950.** A payment for a minimum of 50% of the tuition reserves a student's seat in class. A payment reserving a student's seat in class will not be accepted until students complete an information session, select a class/clinical schedule, and all enrollment paperwork is completed, signed and received by the business office. Students must pay their program tuition in full at least two (2) business days prior to the first day of class, unless they set up a tuition payment plan at the business office at least two (2) business days prior to the first day of class.

- OSBN booklet Nursing Assistants in Oregon** (*provided by the school at no cost*)

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- Shoes (athletic shoes, fully enclosed non-skid soled work shoes)
- Watch w/second hand
- School Supplies (folder, paper, notepad, black pen, highlighters)

A neat, clean, professional appearance is required throughout the program.
Hair pulled back and confined. Tattoos must be covered. False fingernails
or chipped nail polish not allowed. No fragrances. Minimal jewelry.

REQUIRED CLINICAL ITEMS FOR THE FIRST DAY OF CLASS

**** CNA-2 students must pay for, obtain and provide documentation of all OHA, OSBN
and Acute Care/Hospital setting mandated clinical trainings, screenings and immunization
information at least two (2) business days prior to the first day of class
or the student may not go into the clinical setting****

- Criminal Background Check - \$45** (Criminal history checks are run two (2) days prior to the start of class through the school service provider only. Criminal history checks must be paid for in full at least two (2) business days prior to the first day of class or the student will not be allowed to register into the CNA-2 training program.)
- AHA-BLS CPR card - \$52** (Submit your current AHA BLS CPR card to the business office, or sign-up for a CPR class at the school. CPR classes must be paid for in full when registering into the class.)
- TB Test Screening - \$25/each** (CNA-2 students must obtain and provide documentation of a current TB test via Two Step TB Skin (PPD) Test, or a current Quantiferon test, and/or current Chest X-ray for TB documentation. Submit your current TB screening or Chest X-ray Report for TB; or sign up for a TB Skin PPD test through the school. Payment in full is required prior to scheduling TB tests.)
- Drug Screening - \$45** (Drug screening in is done through school service provider only. Payment in full is required prior to obtaining the drug test.)
- Immunization Documentation:** CNA-2 students MUST OBTAIN and provide documentation of the following immunizations: Hep B (Hepatitis B), MMR (measles, mumps & rubella), Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria & pertussis) and Varicella consistent with CDC guidelines and as set by the mandatory hospital requirements and OHA administrative requirements for health professional student placements in clinical training settings within the state of Oregon.
- Influenza (Flu):** CNA-2 students ARE REQUIRED to provide documentation of current Influenza immunization when the injection is available during the flu season. Hospitals will notify the school of timeframe requirements.

****NOTE****

*Criminal Background Checks, Drug Screenings, AHA BLS CPR Classes
and Two Step TB Skin (PPD) Tests through the school must be paid for and completed at least
two (2) business days prior to the first day of class.*

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
