CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT LEVEL 2 (CNA-2) PROGRAM

Caregiver Training Institute (CTI) is excited to offer our OSBN-approved CNA-2 program, which combines Acute Care, Dementia Care and Restorative Care, plus core competencies, into a comprehensive training program including all aspects of the CNA-2 role in a variety of work settings. The CNA-2 training program expands upon the NA-1 program, delving in more depth into Dementia Care and Restorative Care and the technical skills required of employees in the hospital setting. The course consists of a total of 88 hours, 60 hours in class and lab and 28 hours in the clinical setting. Students will be actively involved in the classroom, labs and a clinical rotation in an acute care/hospital setting.

COURSE OPTIONS

The course is offered on alternating **Day** and **Evening** schedules.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- **Must be at least 18 years of age.**
- **Must be able to read, write and communicate in English fluently.**
- **Must be able to pass a criminal background check and drug screening.**
- **Must be listed on the OSBN registry as a CNA in good standing.** OSBN regulations state that students must have an unencumbered Oregon CNA-1 certificate prior to attending the first day of class. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** If you are transferring from another state, you must wait until you are listed on the OSBN website as a CNA in good standing in Oregon to enroll in the CNA-2 program.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

****At least two (2) business days prior to the first day of class, students must have completed an information session; submitted all completed enrollment paperwork and eligibility documentation to the business office; selected a schedule; and paid their criminal background check and tuition fees.****

REGISTRATION PROCESS

- Provide your contact information and view a no-obligation Online CNA-2 Information Session.**
- Go to the school to submit your registration/eligibility paperwork and complete the registration process.** All enrollment paperwork must be completed, signed and received by the school business office at least two (2) business days prior to the first day of class.
- Pay your program fees – Tuition \$1000; Criminal History Fee \$50; CURRENT School CNA-2 Workbook Fee \$40.** A payment for a minimum of 50% of the program tuition reserves a student's seat in class. **A payment reserving a student's seat in class WILL NOT be accepted until students complete an information session, select a class/clinical schedule, and submit all signed completed enrollment paperwork to the business office.** Criminal history fees must be paid in full at least two (2) business days prior to the first day of class. Students must pay their program tuition in full at least two (2) business days prior to the first day of class, unless they set up a tuition payment plan at the business office at least two (2) business days prior to the first day of class.

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REQUIRED ITEMS FOR THE FIRST DAY OF CLASS:

- CURRENT CNA-2 School Workbook - \$40** (*available for purchase ONLY AT THE SCHOOL*)
- Scrubs** (*any color, pattern*); **Shoes** (*athletic shoes, fully enclosed non-skid soled work shoes*)
- Watch w/second hand**
- School Supplies** (*paper, notepad, black pen, highlighters*)
- OSBN booklet *Nusing Assistants in Oregon*** (*available for download during the information session*)
- Name Tag** (*provided by the school*)

A neat, clean, professional appearance is required throughout the program.

*Hair pulled to be pulled back and confined. Tattoos must be covered. Minimal jewelry.
False fingernails and chipped nail polish are not allowed. No fragrances.*

REQUIRED CLINICAL ITEMS FOR THE FIRST DAY OF CLINICAL

**** CNA-2 students must pay for, obtain and provide documentation of all OHA, OSBN and Acute Care/Hospital setting mandated clinical trainings, screenings and immunization information at least two (2) business days prior to the first day of class or the student WILL NOT go into the clinical setting****

- AHA BLS CPR card - \$60** (*Submit your current AHA BLS CPR card to the business office, or sign-up for CPR class at the school.*)
- TB Test Screening - \$60 / \$30 per placement** (*CNA-2 students must obtain and provide documentation of a current TB test via Two Step TB Skin (PPD) Test, or a current Quantiferon test, or a current Chest X-ray for TB documentation. Submit your current TB screening documentation or sign up for a Two Step TB Skin Test (PPD) through the school.*)
- Drug Screening - \$45** (*Drug screening in is DONE ONLY through school service provider.*)

****Payment in full is required when registering for a CPR class, scheduling a TB Test, and prior to obtaining a drug test.****

- Immunization Documentation: CNA-2 students ARE REQUIRED to obtain and provide documentation of the following immunizations: Hep B (Hepatitis B), MMR (measles, mumps & rubella), Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria & pertussis) and Varicella** consistent with CDC guidelines and as set by the mandatory hospital requirements and OHA administrative requirements for health professional student placements in clinical training settings within the state of Oregon.
- Influenza (Flu): CNA-2 students ARE REQUIRED to obtain and provide documentation of current Influenza immunization when the injection is available during the flu season.** Hospitals will notify the school of timeframe requirements.

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
