Clinical Information:

All required items for clinical attendance must be completed and submitted to the office no later than the end of the day on the mid-term exam date.

Program Completion Information:

Upon completion of the program the student will be issued a certificate of training from the school. You will be notified by email when the certificate is ready to be picked up. Your certificate, application to test, and payment for testing must be delivered to the OSBN office either by mail or in person. The OSBN will then notify you by email that you may schedule your fingerprints and how to schedule your state board exam. A link for fingerprint scheduling is in the email from the OSBN.
