Program Information:

- **Cloths or medical masks are required while on campus.** Wearing a mask is required while on campus at all times. We encourage all students to bring their own cloth or medical mask. All required clinical items (see Pg. 2 under clinical requirements) must be completed and delivered to the school two (2) business days PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF CLASS. If all clinical required items are not handed in on time, clinical placement will be affected and the student will not attend a clinical rotation until these items are taken care of. These items are required by law from the Oregon Health Authority.

Required for Clinical Rotation: All required time in the class and lab is completed *per OHA regulations*. And, you have passed the final written exam (required minimum score for passing is 80%). See back page for info on the clinical required items.

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CNA-2 CLINICAL SCHEDULE

Clinical Requirements: To attend the clinical rotation it is the student’s responsibility to provide official documentation on the items listed below. Per the Oregon Health Authority, no student will be allowed in the clinical setting until the school office has received and verified all documentation is accurate and complete.

The following is a list of the required items for clinical attendance:

1. American Heart Association BLS CPR card. Must be current and cannot expire during program.
2. A two-step PPD TB skin or Quantiferon blood test that shows a negative result. If the test shows a positive result, then a chest x-ray with a negative test result must also be obtained.
3. Drug screening is completed and the office has received the results.
4. Immunization record that includes:
 - i. MMR
 - ii. HEP. B
 - iii. TDAP
 - iv. Varicella (or history of chicken pox)
 - v. Current flu vaccine (during flu season)
