PER OSBN REGULATIONS: This is a self-study program. Some information may not be covered in class. It is the students' responsibility to take notes, read and study their workbook, and utilize resources. Students are actively involved in lab and clinical settings, which are graded on a pass/fail basis. Clinical requirements are regulated by the OSBN and the Oregon Health Authority (OHA).

Program Information:

- **Face coverings are required while on campus and must be worn at all times.** We encourage students to bring their own cloth or medical masks.
- **Scrubs are required during lab days and in the clinical rotation.** For dress code info please refer to the student policies.
- **Bring to class all materials** on the program requirements checklist.
- **Please bring a lunch.** You have only 30 minutes for lunch; if you leave for food and are not back on time, you will do makeup time to complete the class and proceed into the clinical rotation. We have microwaves and refrigerators located in the student lounge for your convenience.

Drug screening verification and TB testing must be submitted to the school two (2) business days prior to the first day of class (see Pg. 2 under clinical requirements). If CPR is taken at the school the student does have time to submit the CPR card and will be allowed to attend the clinical after attending the CPR class and passing the exam. If CPR is taken at another site, we cannot allow you into the clinical until the card is sent to the Clinical Coordinator and confirmed it is the correct form of training. If clinical required items are not handed in on time, clinical placement will be affected and the student may not attend a clinical rotation until these items are taken care of. These items are required by law from the Oregon Health Authority.

Clinical Attendance: All required time in the class and lab must completed and a *per OSBN regulations*. A final exam passing score is required to attend clinical rotation also (required minimum score for passing is 80%).

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CNA-2 DAY CLINICAL SCHEDULE

The following is a list of the required items for clinical attendance:

Please note: the TB test and the drug screening must be done before the start of class and handed into the office no later than 2 business days prior to class starting. The drug test can take a week for results to be sent to the office.

1. **American Heart Association BLS CPR card.** Must be current and cannot expire during program. A CPR class attended at the school prior to the clinical is allowed for clinical attendance.
2. **A two-step PPD TB skin or Quantiferon blood test** that shows a negative result. If the test shows a positive result, then a chest x-ray with a negative test result must also be obtained.
3. **Drug screening** completed 1 week before class begins. The office will receive the results from the lab.
4. **Immunization record** that includes:
 - i. **MMR**
 - ii. **HEP. B**
 - iii. **TDAP**
 - iv. **Varicella (or history of chicken pox)**
 - v. **Current flu vaccine (during flu season)**
