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Caregiver Training Institute is the largest Vocational Training School in Oregon that offers training programs that are Oregon State Board of Nursing approved for Nursing Assistant-1 (NA-1), CNA-2, and Med Aide classes. We also offer American Heart Association BLS CPR classes, and Medication Aide CEU hours.

All clinical instructors MUST be licensed as an RN or LPN in Oregon and have one full year of nursing experience. For this position we prefer an RN with Acute Care experience. You will be taking the students into a local hospital and you should know acute care protocols.

- **CNA-2 Clinical Instructor:** this position is 3 days a week on Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday. The clinical is offered twice a month (every other week). The clinical times are from 6:00am to 4:30pm on Sunday and Monday, and from 6:00am to 2:30 pm on Tuesday. The entire clinical is 30 hours.

Responsibilities and Duties

You will be at the same acute care facility for the entire clinical. You will have training at the hospital during your orientation.

CNA-2 Clinical position info: after the student has completed the class and lab and passed the final written exam they proceed into the clinical rotation. This part of the program is working with staff CNA's, doing CNA work, and mastering the skill steps learned in the labs on real patients.

Qualifications and Skills

JOB REQUIREMENTS: To be considered for this position you must be an RN with a current unencumbered license to practice in Oregon. We prefer nurses with acute care experience.

Per OSBN regulations RN instructors must have at least ONE (1) YEAR of FULL TIME experience (or the equivalent in part time work) as a nurse. Please note that your time in the clinical rotations of your nursing program does not count as job experience. **New Grads are not eligible for this position due to these regulations.**

We strive for continuity of training and because of this we do ask that you are able to be in the scheduled time for the entire lab or clinical rotation. **Per OSBN regulations job-sharing is not allowed.** You will be required to apply discipline as needed, complete the documentation as required by the OSBN, and offer a professional attitude as well as emulate what nursing is all about for the students. You will enforce all policies of the school, this may include counseling of the students, documentation of infractions, and potentially dismissing a student from the clinical, and referring them to the Program Director, should they refuse to participate and follow the rules.

We are looking for nurses who have multiple skill-sets and are seasoned in the nursing profession. You will be expected to act in a professional manner, be patient with the students, you must be able to explain curriculum content effectively, and demonstrate all skills to the students.

Preference will be given to those nurses who:



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- ~ have been previously approved as an instructor through the OSBN, or
- ~ have experience training adults in a formal educational setting.
- ~ nurses who desire to be trained into several different positions, and
- ~ are flexible with their scheduling needs (schedules for clinicals must be acceptable as the days and times cannot be changed).

This is a fun and rewarding job and you will find that many of your students want to become nurses. You are training the next generation of healthcare providers.

Clinical Instructors should also have:

- Experience in the acute care setting, and
- An understanding of the role of the CNA as well as their authorized duties.
- Ability to work with and show the students how to care for the residents at the bedside of the facility you are assigned to teach in. This is a physical job. You will be walking the halls and keeping track of your students during their time on the floor. You will be assisting, mentoring, and coaching the students with all aspects of care including the clinical skills that must be signed off during the clinical rotation.

Benefits

We offer dental and vision insurance that the employee pays for but at group rates. We also offer AFLAC and Legal Shield. And, after one year employment we offer a simple IRA (you must meet the time requirement to qualify for this benefit) with a company match. HR can discuss the benefits more at the interview.
